Reading Passage: Read the passage below to learn about the amazing accomplishments of **Dr. Isabella Aiona Abbott**.

- A Dr. Isabella Abbott was born in 1919 in Hana, Maui. Her mother was a native Hawaiian and her father was Chinese. When her father immigrated to Hawaii as a teenager, he found work on a sugar plantation. Later, her father was able to start his own business as the owner of a general store.
- **B** When Isabella was growing up, she and her mother would often go to the beach. She liked to collect and learn about different types of seaweed. Isabella also learned how to use the seaweed to cook **traditional** Hawaiian dishes.
- C Soon Isabella became very **knowledgeable** about Hawaiian seaweed or Limu (the Hawaiian name for **edible** seaweed). She learned about more than seventy varieties of edible seaweed that people would be able to eat. She was very knowledgeable about plants that grow in the ocean.
- D By the time she was in her early thirties, Isabella had earned her doctorate degree in science and had begun to teach and lecture college students. She earned a Ph.D. in botany from the University of California Berkeley. Isabella was the first Native Hawaiian woman to earn a doctoral degree in science. Isabella has discovered over 200 different algae species and many of them have been named for her. One of the species named for her is a division of the red algae family which is called Abbottella or "Little Abbott". Dr. Abbott has written eight books and won many other prestigious awards in science.
